Jim,

Thank you for your comments, our operational plan as of now is to start backing off our generation flows tomorrow (Friday) to target a gradual drop to our July 1 license target elevation of 1341. Our goal will be to match generation to inflow in the last few days of the month to hold the 1341 elevation the best we can; understanding that regardless of inflow we have a minimum required outflow. Silver lake is relatively full and the monthly targets there are timed such that in theory they should help to hold the hoist pond, however Silver lake must be operated to its targets and license requirements regardless of the situation at the Hoist dam.
